I, Jose Maria Delfino Santos, Judge of the Civil State of this Villa, I note that at 12 twelve in the morning appeared in this office the Citizen Benito Rodela, married, laborer, resident of the Hacienda del Potrero of this jurisdiction and he presented a live female child, whom I attest having seen, that was born on the 5 fifth of this month at 2 two in the morning and was named Viviana and he said: she is the legitimate daughter of himself and of his wife Viviana Pena originally from and residents of said hacienda. Paternal grandparents of the child are the Citizen Andres Rodela and Agapita Salinas, maternal are Citizen Pragedis Pena and deceased Paula Guerrero of the same origin and residence: witnesses of this act were the Citizens Antonio M. Garza and Jose Maria Santos, single, employed and residents of this [villa], and in accordance with this act, sign with me, but not Rodela who is unknown to me, the judge. I attest = Jose Maria Delfino Santos = Antonio M. Garza = Jose Maria Santos Gonsales: as directed - This is a copy of the original. I attest. Jose Maria Delfino Santos.

[In the margin] Announcement of Vicente Duran and Carmen Rodela. Act Number (69) sixty-nine. In the town of Villaldama, State of Nuevo Leon, on the (2) second day of the month of September of 1926, nineteen hundred twenty-six. I, Carlos Garay, Judge of the Civil Registry in this Municipality and its Jurisdiction, I note that today at (18) eighteen hours [6 pm] now established at the residence of Senor Andres Rodela, located in the Hacienda de "El Potrero" of this Jurisdiction, I did meet with Senor Vicente Duran and the Senorita Carmen Rodela to celebrate the marriage contract, both celibate, Mexican, Catholics, of mixed race and not related by blood. The first (19) nineteen years of age, miner, originally from and resident of this [villa], and the second (20) [years] of age of the same origin and residence and occupied domestically in the home; Senor Duran declared that he is the legitimate son of Senor Jesus Duran, and of Plutarca Vasquez de

Duran, both of this origin and vicinity, and Senorita Rodela expressed that she is a legitimate daughter also of Benito Rodela and Viviana Pena, deceased. And they expressed their intentions to join in matrimony with all the legal formalities. To justify their suitability, the witnesses presented were Senores Pedro Contreras, Adolfo Flores, Jesus Gonzalez and Julio Mata, all mature of age and from this origin and residence, were questioned under oath to answer truthfully, they declared that they know the spouses and noted they are certain - the liberty of one and the other with relation to their matrimonial bond and their ability in all other respects to form the coming union.

In view of the above statements, the undersigned Judge of the Civil Registration has decided to post an extract of this announcement for the term required by law to the exterior of the office of the Civil Judge; complying along with the other legal requirements. At the ending of this announcement, having been read to those interested and the witnesses, who agree with the content of the reading, those who were known, signed with me, the Judge - I attest - Carlos Garay = Vicente Duran. - Carmen Rodela. - Jesus Duran - Pedro Contreras - Adolfo Flores - Jesus Gonzalez - Julio M Matta - As directed - This copy is identical to the original - I attest. Carlos Garay.

Registration in this Municipality and Jurisdiction, I note that today at (19) nineteen hours [7 pm] I am established in the residence of Senor Andres Rodela, located in the Hacienda de El Potrero of this Jurisdiction and did meet to celebrate the marriage of Senor Vicente Duran and the Senorita Carmen Rodela, the first (19) nineteen years of age, minor, originally from and resident of this [villa] and the second of (20) twenty years of the same origin and residence, and occupied domestically in the home. Senor Vicente Duran said: he is celibate, Mexican, Catholic, of mixed race and not related by blood with Senorita Rodela and that he is the legitimate son of Senor Jesus Duran and Senorita Rodela said also that she is Catholic, Mexican of mixed race and not related by blood to Senor Duran, being the legitimate daughter of Senor Benito Rodela and Viviana Pena, deceased. Confirming this act as witnesses were Senores Guadalupe Trevino, Fulgencio Hernandez, Patricio Gomez ---- and Manuel Gonzalez, mature of age and of this origin and residence, were questioned under oath to answer truthfully, they declared that they know the spouses and noted the freedom they have to unite in matrimony. Both spouses expressed their intentions to marry on the (2) second of September last and the legally required time has passed for the [posting of] publications during which no impediment was presented and having given their consent in the act, the parents of the spouses who are minors have signed, authorizing their bond. Given the completion of the legal requirements, I asked both if their intentions to unite in marriage were voluntary, taking and surrendering mutually as husband and wife, and having both answered in the affirmative. I, the Citizen Judge of the Civil Registry of this place, make the following declaration:

In the name of faith and the Mexican Society, I declare united in perfect legitimate and insoluble matrimony Senor Vicente Duran and the Senorita Carmen Rodela. Having read this act to the spouses and the other persons who participated in this act, they agreed with the contents, and those who were known signed with me, the Judge. I attest - Carlos Garay - Vicente Duran. - Jesus Duran. - Carmen Rodela - Guadalupe Trevino - Benito Rodela - --- --- Gonzalez - Manuel Gonzalez - Fulgencio Hernandez - As directed - This copy is identical to the original - I attest - Carlos Garay.
