

Guadalupe RODELA PENA December 12, 1915 - October 12, 1936

Birth record from July 19, 1929:

[Al margen] Guadalupe Rodela. Acta No 164 siento sesenta y cuatro. - En Villaldama, N. Leon, a los 19 diex y nueve dias del mes de Julio de 1929 mil novecientos veintinueve. Ante mi, Carlos Garay, Juez del Estado Civil en este lugar, comparecio, siendo los 10 diex horas, el Sr. Benito Rodela, Viudo, de 45 curenata y cinco anos de edad, jornalero y de esta vecinidad, y me mostro una constancia del C. Presidente Municipal de esta Ciudad, en la que aparece que el citado Senor ha sufrido el castigo correspondiente por haber infringido el Art 68 del Codigo Civil vigente en el Estado, al no haber registrados a su debido tiempo a su hijo Guadalupe que nacio en la Hacienda de "El Potrero" el dia 12 doce de Diciembre del anos de 1915 mil novecientos quince a las 8 ocho horas, siendo 4e hijo legitimo de el y de su esposa Viviana Pena, ya finada. Son abuelos paternos: Andres Rodela y Agapita Salinas y maternos: Praxedis Pena y Paula Guerrero, finados los tres ultimos. Fueron testigos de este acto los Senores: Antonio Franco G y Enrique Garay, mayores de edad y de esta vecinidad, quienes de conformidad, firmaron conmigo el Juez. Doy fe. - Carlos Garay. - Antonio Franco G - Enrique Garay. - Rubricas. - Es copia fil y correcto de su original. Doy fe. Carlos Garay

[In the margin] Guadalupe Rodela. Act No. 164 one hundred sixty-four. - In Villaldama, N. Leon, on the 19 nineteen of July of 1929 nineteen hundred twenty-nine. Before me, Carlos Garay, Judge of the Civil State of this place, appeared at 10 ten hours, the Senor Benito Rodela, Widow, of 45 forty-five years of age, laborer and resident, and he gave evidence from the Mayor of this City, showing that the cited Senor has suffered the corresponding punishment for infringement of Article 68 of the Civil Code of this State, not having registered within the required time, his son Guadalupe born at the Hacienda of "El Potrero" on the 12 twelve of December of the year 1915 nineteen hundred fifteen at 8 eight hours [8 a.m.], 4th legitimate son of himself and of his wife Viviana Pena, deceased. Paternal grandparents: Andres Rodela and Agapita Salinas and maternal: Praxedis Pena and Paula Guerrero, latter three deceased. Witnesses of this act were the Senores: Antonio Franco G and Enrique Garay, mature of age and residents, who agreeing, signed with me, the Judge. I attest. - Carlos Garay. - Antonio Franco G - Enrique Garay. - As directed. - This is a true and correct copy of the original. I attest. Carlos Garay.
